## **Pre-Entrance Exam Test Dates (TEAS Test)**

For Admission into the Fall 2026 Semester or Later

You may register to take the exam **beginning Monday, September 1, 2025**. **Deadline for registration is 4:30 p.m. on Friday, October 17, 2025. This is a firm deadline. Registration will not be taken after October 17th.** To register, please email [dmcDonou@lc.edu](mailto:dmcDonou@lc.edu). Please provide the following: your name, your Social Security Number or student ID number, phone number, and the day you would like to test – (Your ID number is **not** the number on the back of your L&C photo ID. This number can normally be found on BlazerNet, Self-Service, or an invoice from the college.) We will reply to your email once your registration has been confirmed along with instructions on setting up your ATI/TEAS account which must be set up prior to testing. Please do not send your information through an encrypted email that requires account set up. They will not be checked. If you have questions and would like to talk to someone in the Nursing Department, please call 618-468-4401 or 618-468-4410. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday, closed from noon – 1 p.m. for lunch.

- ✓ A photo ID will be required in order to test; i.e. Driver's License, L&C photo ID card.
- ✓ Bring a pen or pencil.
- ✓ **The cost of the exam is \$70 + tax. You MUST have a Debit/Credit card. You will pay ATI (TEAS) for the exam online the day you test. No cash or check!**
- ✓ You do not need to bring a calculator. The exam has a built-in calculator. You will not be allowed to use your own.
- ✓ Test is given in the Assessment & Testing Center, Haskell Hall, B25. (If you've previously tested in the Nursing Building, it has been moved to HK B25)
- ✓ Total testing time is 149 minutes. If you complete the exam early, you may leave the room. Check in begins approximately 30 minutes before the start of the exam. **Students who arrive after the scheduled start time will not be allowed to take that exam. If the remaining testing dates are full or there are no additional testing dates, you will have to wait until the next testing period.**

The exam is multiple choice. You must take the exam in the order above – Reading, Math, then English & Language.

**There is limited space available for each testing date.**

The nursing pre-entrance exam (TEAS) may be taken an unlimited number of times. However, you can only test one time during a testing period. For example, you may only take the test one time during the October 2025 testing period. You cannot retake the test again until the Spring 2026 semester (normally in April). Once you test, your scores are good for 5 years. This is an online test. **Only test scores completed at L&C will be considered.**

**NOTE:** These testing dates are for students who wish to be considered for admission in August (Fall semester) of 2026 or later.

**NEW TEAS Prep Course:** The Nursing Program is offering a TEAS Prep Course to help you prepare for the TEAS pre-entrance exam. It is a 1-credit hour course. It will help prepare students for the Math, Reading, and English & Language portions of the exam. We do not test on the science section. The course will be offered the 1<sup>st</sup> 8 weeks of the Spring and Fall semesters and will conclude prior to testing.

**Testing Information:** Areas to study: Reading, Math, English and Language. We are not testing on any science. Students must receive the following minimum scores to be considered for the program: Reading – 71.8%; Math – 76.5%; English & Language – 60%. Once the minimum requirements are met, we then use a point system for individual sections. Those receiving the most points and who have met all requirements will then be selected for admission. **Please note that meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into the program. If you have not met the minimum score requirements, you will not be considered for admission.** You can continue to take the test one time during each testing period. Students must also have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better for the last 5 years in order to be considered for admission.
