It is estimated that by the year 2016, there will be a shortage of one million nurses.”

About the Nursing Program

The Associate Degree Nursing program prepares students to be eligible to apply for NCLEX-RN licensing. Graduates passing the exam are then able to apply for a license to practice as registered professional nurses (RN).
