The Lewis and Clark Community College Foundation shall review all applications and make all selections.

Criteria/Conditions:

- Students receiving a state of Illinois MAP Grant, Federal Financial Aid (Pell Grant), a scholarship and/or an L&C Student Emergency Loan are eligible to receive this award, but must have used all of the funds available to them before applying for support.
- Students must be women.
- Students must have at least a 2.0 GPA.
- Students must submit a completed application to L&C Student Development and Counseling.
- Request for support must be for opportunities above and beyond curricular requirements.
- Requests cannot be for emergencies such as food, clothing, shelter, transportation, books,
- Students must have a letter of recommendation from an L&C professor, counselor, or department director (other than the Student Development Director).
- Students receiving support are required to write a thank you note to The Echo Academy, or individual donor, whichever the case warrants.
- Students receiving support are required to attend The Echo Academy events and speak publicly about the impact of the financial support.
