

## Getting Started as a Student Veteran at Lewis and Clark

The following recommendations are designed to help students complete the initial steps necessary to receive VA Educational Benefits. - STEP 1: Apply for your VA Educational benefits at https://www.va.gov/education/
- For **GI Bill**® specific questions, please call the VA Education Division directly at: 1-888-GI-BILL-1 (or 1-888-442-4551)
- **STEP 2:** Complete a **FAFSA** (Federal Application for Federal Student Aid) at <a href="https://www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a>. Veteran students who are eligible for Federal Financial Aid can also receive the VA benefits.
- **STEP 3:** Complete an LC application at: <a href="https://www.lc.edu/prospective-students/index.html">https://www.lc.edu/prospective-students/index.html</a> and clicking "Apply to L&C".
- STEP 4: If you have attended any other schools, submit official school transcripts to:

**STEP 6:** Complete the required paperwork to start using your **VA Educational Benefits** on the Veterans Education Benefits webpage: <a href="www.lc.edu/vet-benefits">www.lc.edu/vet-benefits</a>

If eligible for the **Illinois Veterans Grant** or the **Illinois National Guard Grant**, complete the application online by selecting "Program Applications & Status Checks" at: <a href="https://studentportal.isac.org/">https://studentportal.isac.org/</a>. Turn in your Eligibility Letter by uploading through the **Required Documents for New LC Veterans link** (located here: <a href="https://www.lc.edu/vet-benefits">www.lc.edu/vet-benefits</a>) once received.

If you are a dependent and eligible for the State of Illinois <u>MIAPOW Scholarship</u>, please apply here: <a href="https://studentportal.isac.org/">https://studentportal.isac.org/</a>. Turn in your Eligibility Letter by uploading through the **Required Documents for New LC Veterans link** (<a href="https://www.lc.edu/vet-benefits">www.lc.edu/vet-benefits</a>) once received.

## The required documents for NEW LC Veterans & Dependents are:

- Service Member's DD214 Member 4
- Your VA Certificate of Eligibility Letter
- IVG / ING / MIAPOW Eligibility Letter/Card (if applicable)
- Notice of Basic Eligibility (for those in the National Guard and Reservists only)
- Signed Veteran's Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards Form
- Previous Education Form
- Certification Request Form (Must submit every semester)
- IVG Responsibility Form (IVG only)
- Proof of Illinois Residency (IVG only)
- Your Semester Schedule (Must submit every semester)
- Change in Place of Training or Program Form (if applicable)
