



APPLYING FOR THE EMT OR PARAMEDICINE (PMED) PROGRAM

APPLY TO Lewis & Clark Community College:

- Complete Lewis and Clark Community College application. Follow the steps below:
- Log on to the L&C website at www.lc.edu
- Click on "Apply Now" and create an account (contact the enrollment center at 618-468-2222 for assistance if needed)
- Select "Health Science" for student type
- Select "Paramedicine" for student program
- After application is submitted, please contact (618) 468-2273 to schedule an advising appointment.

SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS:

- Submit an official high school transcript showing proof of graduation, or GED® scores (recognized by a state-accredited provider) which qualify as a high school equivalency certificate within any of the fifty states to enroll@lc.edu
- Submit official transcripts from all post-secondary educational institutions attended to enroll@lc.edu

TAKE PLACEMENT TEST:

- You may be required to complete placement testing, based on program entrance requirements. Please see entrance requirements below for additional information.
- Contact the testing center at (618) 468-5232 or testingcenter@lc.edu to set up your placement test if required.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: EMT

- Qualify for ENGL 125 or an approved equivalent course.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Valid driver's license.
- Those pursuing professional EMT certification must be at least 18 years of age.
 - Individuals may enroll in class prior to their 18th birthday with the understanding that they will not be able to test for certification until age requirements are met.
- Current Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR card (preferably from the American Heart Association) prior to class or obtained within the first two weeks of class. No other card will be accepted by the program.
- Meet all the requirements as stated in the L&C Admission procedures above.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: PARAMEDICINE

- Qualify for ENGL 131 / ENGL 137 or an approved equivalent course.
- Qualify for MATH 112 or an approved equivalent course.
- NREMT Certification or State of Illinois EMT license obtained by 1st day of PMED 131.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Valid driver's license.
- Provide a copy of your current Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers (CPR) card from the American Heart Association (AHA). No other card will be accepted by the certifying agency.
- Meet all the requirements as stated in the L&C Admission procedures above.
- BIOL 132- Human Biology or equivalent anatomy & physiology class approved by the program coordinator with a grade of C or better.
- BIOL 120- Medical Terminology or equivalent medical terminology course approved by the program coordinator with a grade of C or better.
