



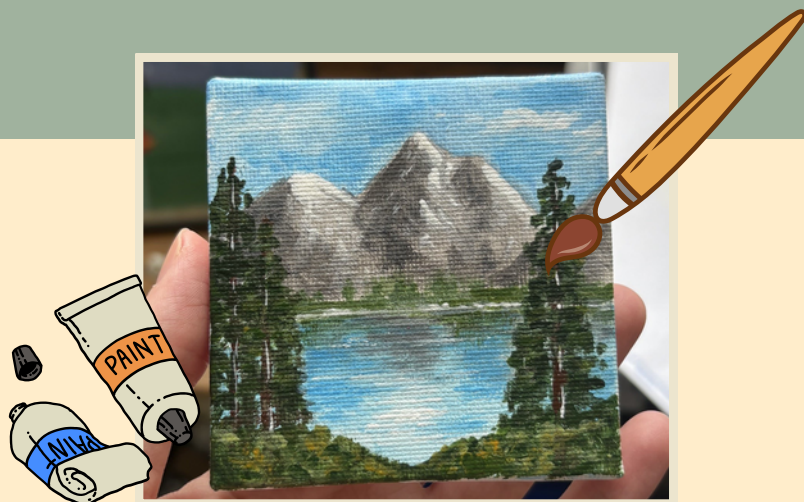

So Who is CARLI Anyway?

It's understandable that someone may think of CARLI as someone's name. But in the case of Reid Library, CARLI is not a person but a thing.

More specifically, CARLI is an acronym for the "Consortium of Academic and Research Libraries in Illinois". Yes, that's a mouthful hence the acronym CARLI.

There are 122 college and university libraries in Illinois that are members of CARLI, including LC. Of these, 94 libraries share their collections through the I-Share online catalog.

So what's the big deal?

Well, the big deal is that the I-Share catalog provides access to over 38 million items. In fact, it's the third largest academic library collection in the United States. When looking for a book, video, or other item in the Reid Library catalog you can also

search the other 93 I-Share libraries.

If you see something that you like, you can request that it be delivered to Reid Library. Voila!
