Deadline to submit entries: Monday, March 24th, by 3 p.m. <u>2D work must be matted with matte board and framed for jury process</u>. Bring work to be juried, with **two** attached entry forms for each piece submitted, to these locations:

Eligibility: All 2-D and 3-D works made by LC students enrolled in Art studio courses during Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 school year. All work must be completed as part of class requirements for courses taken at L&C during this school year. Students are limited to 3 submissions in any particular courses/medias (Painting, Drawing I and II, Figure Drawing, Basic Design I and II, Ceramics, 3D Design and Graphic/Web Design).

Rules of Entry:

- 2 -Dimensional work must be framed with wire attached properly. Do not use tape to hold the wire on the back of the frame. Leave a two-inch space from the wire to the top of the frame. NO saw tooth hangers, D-rings, keyhole mounts or tacks ... etc.
- All paintings must be completely dry for exhibition.
- Wall hung 3-D art must be installation ready with wire, mounts, etc... already attached. Not just wire or mounts *included*, but attached properly with appropriate hanging hardware.
- All other 3-D art must be stable and pedestal ready.
- No ceiling displayed works.
- No installation works.
- All accepted artwork must be delivered to Hatheway Gallery no later than 4p.m. on Thursday, March 27th. We do not accept late works delivered after 4pm—NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Affix two copies of the entry form (last page of this form) to each entry.
- Students must pick up artwork on Tuesday, April 29 between 2pm-4pm and Wednesday, April 30 between 2pm-4pm.
- We do not exhibit works don't meet these requirements.
