Skills required and responsibilities:

- Must be able to lift and carry 50 lbs.
- Must have valid IL driver's license
- Must be able to work outdoors in adverse conditions (heat, humidity, rain, etc.)
- Must be able to comfortably use common gardening tools and operate 2-cycle engine landscaping equipment (leaf blower, weed whipper, etc.)
- Must be able to observe landscape areas that require attention and independently work to improve those areas
- Must have a basic understanding of gardening/landscaping techniques and can identify most weeds common to the region
- An active pesticide applicator's license is preferred, but not required
